



Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

About the scholarship:

The Morgan Miller Plumbing Scholarship is a full scholarship to the Johnson County Community College Plumbing Technology program. The scholarship is for the one-year daytime program and is payable at the start of each semester for up to one full year for the purpose of obtaining a Plumbing Technology Certification. Awardee's will also be granted a paid apprenticeship with Morgan Miller Plumbing and will be working on the days not in school. A minimum one-year commitment for continued employment after completing the program will be expected.

Who can apply?

Any senior high school student who will be enrolling in the Johnson County Community College Plumbing Technology program with the purpose of obtaining a Plumbing Technology Certification may apply.

What do I need to apply?

- Completed Morgan Miller Plumbing Scholarship Application
- Current transcript of high school or trade school grades
- Two letters of recommendation from any of the following – teacher, adviser, activity leader or supervisor

Deadline to Apply:

All applications must be received in the Morgan Miller Plumbing office no later than May 31st at 3:00pm.

Judging of Applicants:

All scholarship applications received by the deadline will be reviewed by the Morgan Miller Plumbing Scholarship Committee. Individual applications will be judged on the following:

- Scholastic standing
- ACT and/or SAT scores
- Career goals
- Essay
- Thoroughness of completed application

Applicants will also be required to attend an in-person interview with the Scholarship Committee before the final scholarship selection is determined. This is a merit-based scholarship and is not based on applicant's needs.

Maintaining Eligibility:

To receive your scholarship check for each semester, you must be enrolled in an accredited college, university or trade school and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.75. Morgan Miller Plumbing must receive your transcript at our offices no later than June 30 (for fall semester) and December 31 (for spring semester) of each year.
